WHEREAS, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved March 3, 1855, entitled "An Act in addition to certain Acts granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the military service of the United States," there has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE,

Warrant No. 42171 for 160 acres, in favor of *Mary Campbell* widow of *Samuel Campbell*, private, *Captain Caldwell's Company Ohio Militia Mar 1812.*

with evidence that the same has been duly located upon *the South West Quarter of Section Twenty in Township twelve of Range Seventeen, in the district of lands subject to sale at LeCompton Kansas containing One hundred and Sixty acres.*

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of said Lands returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL *the said warrant having been assigned by the said Mary Campbell to Jacob P French in whose favor said tract has been located.*

NOW KNOW YE, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said *Jacob P French as assignee as aforesaid and his heirs*

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *Jacob P French as assignee as aforesaid and his*

heirs and assigns forever.
